















Why Adapt SAP GUI Applications to SAP Fiori?

Usability Issues That Are Emphasized by The New Theme

Causes of Usability Issues:

- Badly maintained texts for GUI functions
- Wrong usage of icons
- Large screens without resizing

Adoption is Required to Get Best User Experience

- Optimize header and footer toolbar
- Make use of new theme specific features
- Improve screen layout








Application Adaptation: GUI Status

General

- Ensure self-explanatory texts
- Hide less important, and remove unwanted functions



Special Functions

- Closing actions (Footer)
- *Enter* button
- Display/Change button
- View switch
- Popup window buttons

Exit

Items

Application Adaptation: Dynpro

Sizing and Spacing

- Remove unnecessary horizontal scrollbars
- Add proper spacing (e.g. above TabStrip, Tables)

Alignment

- Add missing label assignments
- Fix CheckBox & RadioButton alignment

Icons

- Correct use of status icons
- Semantic and consistent icon usage



Alignment of CheckBoxes and RadioButtons

Full Screen ALV / ABAP Lists

- Standard functions are still displayed as icons

- Check header & footer
- 2. Check element alignment in content area
- 3. Check for structure of screen and unnecessary scrollbars
- 4. Directly solve issues using Menu Painter and Screen Painter








Summary and Outlook




